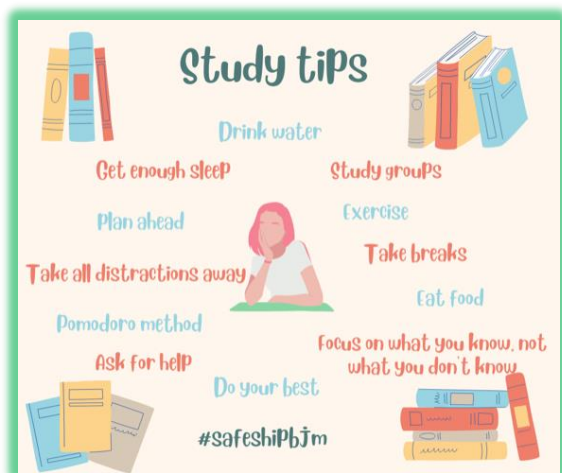
**The cafeteria will be closed all week.** Please plan ahead if you need a snack during final assessments.
