Eligibility for Graduation

To be eligible for Graduation, a student must:

- Have at least 19 credits before entering 2nd Semester.
- Including 5 level 30 credits
- Be registered in enough courses that will total at least 24 credits by the end of June.
- Have passed or be passing all required courses at midterm of Sem 2. Students who are not in this position will meet with administration
- Attend the Grade 12 Retreat May
- Complete the application to Graduate Form – TODAY
- Pay all school fees.

Honour Roll

- Based on the Sem 1 marks and Sem 2 midterm marks.
- If you are taking a cyber school class, you must be completed ½ the course (midterm) for it to be used in the calculation. If you are not, it will not be used for honour roll and may not be eligible. MONDAY APRIL 24th

Honour Roll French Immersion

 - ✓ 4 next highest Level 30 classes


