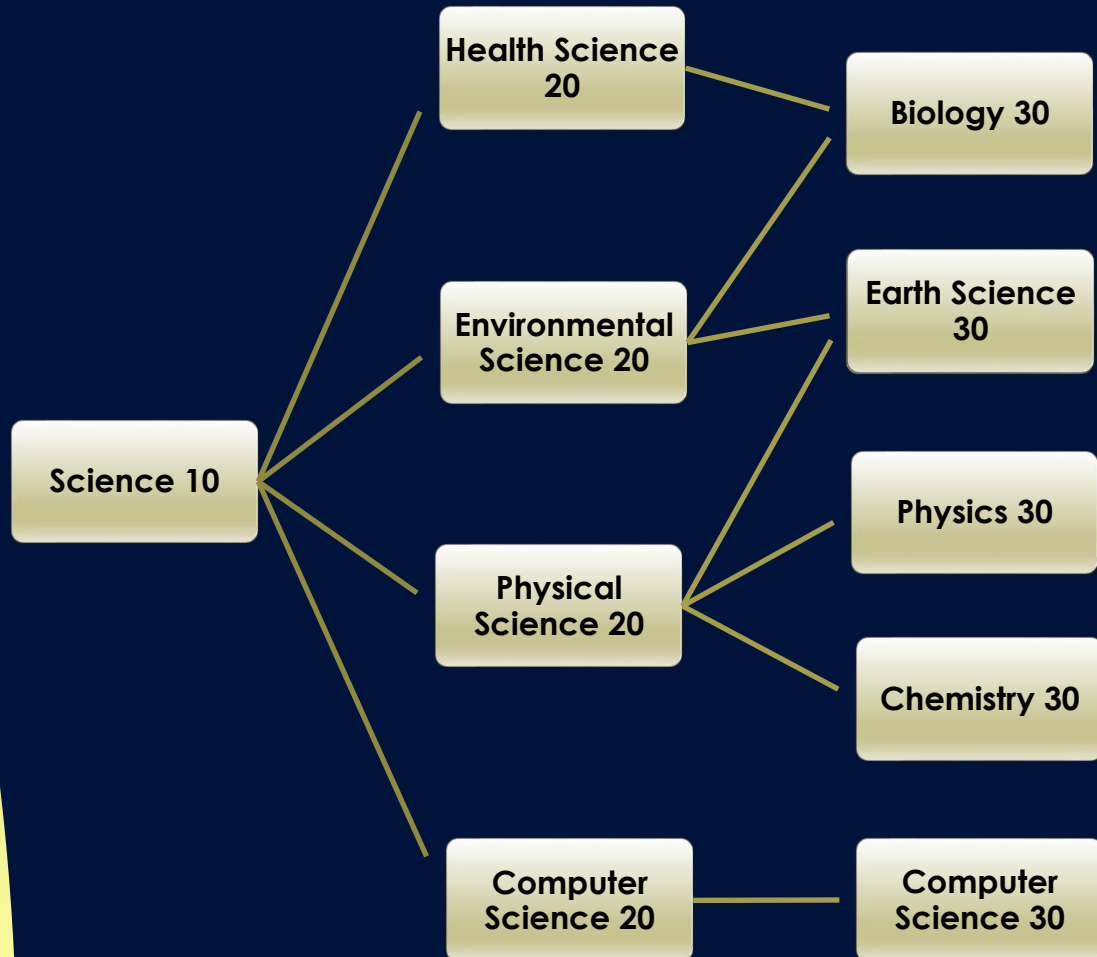

Sunday, March 12th

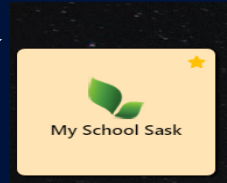

# How to Register

1. Go to your Portal: [portal.gscs.ca](https://portal.gscs.ca)
2. Click on *My School Sask*



3. You will have to sign in using your student number email and password again.
4. Once in, click on the top tab My Info and then the side tab Requests.

  7. Be sure to click OK after your make your selections.
