PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

As the month of May begins, we have several exciting events and plans as we come closer to the conclusion of this school year. This week, we are celebrating Catholic education and the gift of learning within a faith-filled environment. Face to Face ministries will be facilitating our Student Retreat today. We will have the K-4 and 5-8 participating in separate presentations throughout the day in our gym and students will have the opportunity to participate in several activities such as a Living Rosary, Scavenger Hunt and the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Students are encouraged to dress in white for our Student Retreat Day!

The annual Tiger Idol talent show will not take place during our typical timeframe at the end of April. This year's in-person Tiger Idol for our entire school will be scheduled the last week of the year on June 27th and 28th with a tentative starting time of 12:15. Auditions for interested grade 4-8 students will take place the first week of June! More information will be provided in weekly community announcements to parents and during morning announcements for students.

Our school continues to be very busy preparing for our Treaty Flag and Medal Ceremony that is scheduled for Wednesday, June 1st. Tyler Thunderchild will join our school on May 19th to provide small group instruction about the Round Dance and our entire school will have the opportunity to participate in a Round Dance outside in the afternoon. Our ceremony program will consist of a blessing of our flag and medal, guest speakers, and

videos that represent our learning during the past few years. We look forward to celebrating we are all treaty people!

Our school track meet will take place on Tuesday, May 24th. There will be scheduled events for grade 4-8 students in our gym and outside on our soccer field and ball diamond. Students will participate in sprints and field events within their appropriate age and grade level. Our school representatives for each event will participate in a division meet on June 7th. More information will be provided to students regarding specific times and dates of each event in the coming days.

Our St. Mother Teresa Cup floor hockey tournament is presently taking place with 8 teams consisting of grade 6-8 boys and girls. The cup will be presented on May 17th to the winning team! Grade 8 students will be participating in a year-end camping trip May 26th and 27th at Camp Kadesh. We wish them an enjoyable time together and with their teachers as they conclude their elementary education.

Our annual St. Mother Teresa Yearbook will be published this year with many new pages that summarize an exciting year in 2021-22. Parents of grade 8 students are encouraged to purchase a copy or two as this cohort will have some special pages assigned to them. Please encourage your children to keep these items in their backpacks. We appreciate your anticipated cooperation.

Please encourage any neighbors and parents who may be considering English or French Immersion at St. Mother Teresa to contact the school (306-659-7240) at their earliest convenience if they have any questions regarding our school or registration procedures. Children must be five years of age by January 31, 2023 to begin kindergarten in the fall.

With the announcement of a new K-4 French immersion program at Father Robinson School for the 2022-23 school year, parents with children in K-3 are asked to notify our school (call 306-659-7240) of their intentions to remain or move to the new program. Families with students in grade 5-8 French immersion at St. Mother Teresa will remain at our school with any younger siblings – transportation will be provided from the designated areas now assigned to Father Robinson. The catchment areas of Willowgrove, Erindale, Arbor Creek, Forest Grove and Sutherland are now designated areas for Father Robinson.

As the school year is coming to an end in the coming weeks, we are requesting parents of both the English and French immersion streams to inform the school if their child will not be returning to St. Mother Teresa for the 2022-23 school year. Please call the office at 306-659-7240 to let Ms. Kammermayer know. If we are not advised of any changes, your child will automatically be registered for next year. Thank you for your anticipated cooperation.
