

2 Executive Limitations

2.0 General Executive Constraint

Policy

The Director of Education shall not cause or allow in Greater Saskatoon Catholic Schools any practice, activity, decision or circumstance which is either imprudent or unethical.

1. With respect to the goals to be achieved as detailed in the Educational Commitment Statement and the annual Greater Saskatoon Catholic Schools Strategic Plan of the Board of Education, the director of education shall not cause or allow programs or activities which deter from the mission of Greater Saskatoon Catholic Schools.
2. The director of education shall not cause or allow harm to the Catholic identity or the fiscal integrity of the division with respect to employment, compensation or benefits for employees, contract workers, and volunteers.
3. With respect to the actual, ongoing financial operations of Greater Saskatoon Catholic Schools, the director of education shall not cause or allow budgeting for any fiscal year or the remaining part of any fiscal year to deviate materially from Board of Education priorities, risk fiscal jeopardy, fail to demonstrate a generally acceptable level of foresight, or allow division assets to be unprotected or inadequately maintained.
4. To maintain records, files, and critical operations of Greater Saskatoon Catholic Schools, in the event of a sudden loss of chief executive officer services, the director of education shall not have fewer than two other designees familiar with Board of Education and operational issues and processes.
5. The director of education shall not have fewer than two other designees familiar with Board of Education and operational issues and processes in order to maintain records, files, and critical operations of Greater Saskatoon Catholic Schools.
6. The director of education shall not permit the Board of Education to be uninformed of information or counsel as deemed necessary for decision-making of the board.
7. With respect to interactions with the public, the director of education shall not operate in disregard of the direction of the Board of Education.
8. The director of education shall not deviate from the responsibilities as defined in the Policy Governance Decision Matrix.
