## Greetings from your Administrative Team...

### [Have You Thought About How We Determine Your Child's Classroom Placement?](#)

Although we are busy enjoying the last few weeks of our school year, we are already in the midst of planning for next year. This is an exciting time and it is hard to believe we are already at the end of April. We will soon be in the process of arranging classrooms. Our goal is to build a community of learners in every classroom and to do this we strive to ensure that the best interests of students are central in all decisions about classroom placement. We take classroom placements very seriously and as professionals spend much time collaborating in making the best choices for our students. Some significant factors include:

- Student's strengths and interests
- Work habits
- Class dynamics
- Student needs (e.g. need for support in learning English or academic areas)
- Relationships with peers
- Learning styles
- Number of boys and girls in the class
- Social skills
- Number of students in each grade
- Curricular needs

Once again, we give much thought and time in making decisions about your child's placement. Although some students and their parents wish to have their closest friends with them in their class, that is not always the best decision for learning. We are hoping that we will have many opportunities for children to collaborate with grade alike groupings, recess and extra-curricular activities next year.

Later in May we will also be sending out a digital form for families to complete to help us with our decision making.

Since we have a capable and talented staff that sincerely cares about our students, teacher requests will not be accepted. In addition, we anticipate some combined classrooms. Our teachers ensure curriculum outcomes are being met in both single and multi-graded classrooms; therefore, requests for straight grade classrooms will not be considered. ### Water Bottles

Please remember to send water bottles with your child(ren). Cups at the office are for emergency only, not a daily occurrence. Thanks for your help with this.

### Safety At Our Crosswalks

This is just a reminder to be safe when crossing our streets at the crosswalks. Please don't ever assume that a car will stop. Make sure that cars come to a complete stop before crossing the streets. We do not want any of our students hurt. Please talk this over with your child(ren) and remind them of this very important safety concern.

### Parking Out Front

As the weather is getting colder, parking can and will be a problem out front. Please remember to not get out of your vehicle, as these are drop off and pick up spots only. Traffic jams are very common around 3:30 as well – to help avoid this – you could tell your kids to meet you at the Willowgrove square area or arrive 10 -15 minutes later to help avoid the line ups. There is no great solution to this parking issue, so please try your best to help us with it. Also, **do not park in the Daycare spots** – these are courtesy spots meant for parents with young children and babies who are taking their kids to and from the daycare.

### School Arrival

Students should not be at school prior to 8:45 in the morning. Exterior doors will remain locked until 8:45AM. If students need to arrive early, we have a Before and After School Program available through Preston Early Learning. In addition, students are asked to proceed directly into the school when they arrive since there is no supervision on the playground prior to 9AM.

If your child/children arrive late, the door they normally enter in will be locked, so please have them enter through the front door and *let the office know they have arrived.*

### Attendance and Edsby

Please remember to use Edsby to report all absences and planned absences. If you still have not received an invitation to Edsby, please let the school know. Once you have accepted, you will also see all of our newsletters, calendar of upcoming events and any other important information. You are not able to put your child's entry into Safe Arrival anymore, so please make sure you have an account through Edsby. If you need any assistance, please contact the school office at 306-659-7850 and we can help you.

### Kindergarten Registration

We are always accepting registrations for our upcoming school year for kindergarten. Children who will be 5 years old by January 31, 2023 are eligible to start school next fall.
