Admission Requirements

1. GRADUATION FROM HIGH SCHOOL

You may apply for admission in the year you will graduate if you provide your most up-to-date report card or transcript, as well as a list of classes/subjects you will complete prior to graduation.

2. ADMISSION AVERAGE

For students with no previous post-secondary education (fewer than 18 transferable credit units), an admission average is calculated using marks for five acceptable Grade 12 (senior-level) subjects:

- 1 Mathematics
- 1 English
- 3 Other acceptable Grade 12 (senior-level) subjects from the following
 - Maximum of TWO natural sciences
 - Maximum of TWO social sciences or humanities
 - Maximum of ONE fine or performing art

Applications are considered throughout the admissions cycle and admission is offered on a first-qualified, first-accepted basis.
