Cameco is offering a FREE two-month activity program (June and September) for students in Grades 4-8 with a celebration event on September 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2022, at Diefenbaker Park in Saskatoon.

For three years, Cameco has organized Step Up for Mental Health – a 5km/10km run or walk in Saskatoon to raise money for mental health supports in our province. This year's run is September 24<sup>th</sup>, 2022, through the streets of downtown Saskatoon. Adults can register at <u>www.stepupsk.ca</u>. Cameco donates all registration fees for all adults – and matches all registration fees – to mental health charities in our province. In the first three years, Cameco has donated \$1.3 million.

This is the fourth year of Step Up for Mental Health, and this year, Cameco wanted to offer a student version on September 23rd, the day before the adult run. The student version is entirely FREE and is open to the first 2,000 students who register through schools contacting Cameco.

We think this activity will begin after school on Sept 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2022, but we do not have any specifics yet. More information will be communicated as soon as possible.
